Weekly themes highlight Summer Program

Bon Appétit, Puzzle Mania, Discovery Canyon, and Arctic Blast are among the weekly themes for the 2009 Summer Program at Shepherd of the Valley. Instruction and activities center around each week's theme.

SOV teachers lead the Morning Sessions, while Club House Staff guide the Afternoon Sessions.

Mini sports camps are featured during some morning sessions; individualized computer instruction in

animation and game design are featured in others. There are also art classes.
